

## Website Launch Checklist

Check your spelling and grammar on every page of
your site.
There are several free online spell and grammar checkers available. Or you can copy/paste the text into Word or Grammarly and check each page individually. Paid services are also available such as <a href="Respect">Respect</a> .
Check your site in multiple browsers and on mobile
devices.
It's best to test these manually, but you can also try a paid service such as <u>Cross Browser Testing</u> .
Test your links.
There are several programs available for free. Chrome has an extension for this called Broken Link Checker or try <u>Online</u> <u>Broken Link Checker</u> or <u>W3C LinkChecker</u> .
Check to be sure all images have Alt text descriptions.
Manually test any forms on your site.
Check your 404 pages.
It is best to have a custom 404 error page. You can check your error page by typing in a non-existent page to your browser window to get on a 404 error page.
Check your 301 redirects.
If you created a whole new URL structure, you'll want to create 301 redirects for pages that changed and test to make sure they redirect as expected.
Check your XML site map and make sure it is rendering correctly.
Test your social media icons and make sure they are taking your site visitors where you want them to go.
Point your DNS at your new hosting name servers.
